



**PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP OF NAHPA AND
BENEFITS ACCRUED TO MEMBER INSTITUTION
(FORMER NAME- INDIAN PARAMEDICAL ASSOCIATION)**

1. Conditions approved by the Governing Council of NAHPA in its meeting held on 19 JULY, 2024 for granting Provisional Membership of NAHPA.

For getting provisional membership of NAHPA the Institution must be Registered under Central/State Government Act, Allied Health Care Profession Act 2021, section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956, or any other Govt law.

2. Procedure for applying for provisional membership of NAHPA:

The Institution is required to submit the following documents for grant of provisional membership of NAHPA:

- (i) Duly filled membership form {available on the NAHPA Website (www.ipmabharat.com) under 'Download Section'}.
- (ii) A copy of Central/State Govt Affiliation Letter, UGC letter mentioning that the Institution is included under govt body
- (iii) A copy of Gazette Notification/ Affiliation Letter in respect of establishment of the Institution.
- (iv) A copy of the Act/ Affiliation Letter of the Institution
- (v) A copy of audited account of the Institution for the last year.
- (vi) **₹ 11,000 one time as Processing fee (one time) and Annual membership fee of ₹ 50,000/- Per Annum to be submitted through NAHPA Online Payment Portal.**

3. Benefits accrued to member universities of the NAHPA :

- (i) The Vice Chancellor of member Institution may be nominated on the Governing Council of NAHPA based on their individual and institutional seniority.
- (ii) AIU maintains a close relationship with international organizations in the field of higher education including the Commonwealth of Learning, Association of Commonwealth Universities and the Commonwealth Secretariat.
- (iii) Also, NAHPA works closely with the following National Level Organizations:
 - Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi
 - Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, New Delhi
 - University Grants Commission, New Delhi
 - All India Council for Technical Education, New Delhi
 - Indian Council for Agricultural Research, New Delhi
 - Indian Council for Cultural Relations, New Delhi
 - Education Departments of various States and State Councils
 - National Sports Federations of India
 - Ministry of Family and Health Welfare New Delhi
- (iv) NAHPA organizes Annual Conference of all Principals/Directors of member Universities/Institutions. The conference is attended by eminent educationists, international experts, representatives of UGC, MHRD and heads of apex bodies. The NAHPA member universities/ Institutions get free invite for this conference of VCs where they can meet fellow Principals/Directors MHRD and UGC Officials and deliberate on issues of national importance relating to higher education and Allied Health Care Education.
- (v) The NAHPA) organizes Three Zonal Meets of Principals/Directors every year wherein issues relating to higher education are discussed amongst the Principals/Directors of that zone. All Principals/Directors of NAHPA member Universities/Institutions of the respective zone get free invite for the Zonal Conferences.
- (vi) NAHPA also organizes various Round Table Conferences of Principals/Directors on emerging issues in higher education and Health Education. The main objective of organizing such programmers is to bring the Principals/Directors and Senior Academics and policymakers on a common platform to discuss and

deliberate on the problems and issues relating to higher education. This paves the way for preparing a broader framework on the policy formation on issues of national importance. The NAHPA member universities Universities/Institutions are invited for such meets.

- (vii) Further, AIU Sports Division also organizes the Capacity-building and Sports Management programmes for up-dating professional knowledge, technical skills and promoting anti-doping awareness among the athletes and support staff, on the regular basis. The continuous professional development of the faculty (coaches, trainers and Sports scientists) which is of paramount importance for effective management of Institution Sports, broad-basing Sports and achieving excellence at global competitions.
- (viii) NAHPA International Cell promotes and felicitates Internationalization of Higher Education necessitating increasing international academic collaboration in the areas of common interest particularly exchange of students/faculty/research and technical staff, joint research projects, sharing of information, joint capacity building programme, credit transfer, dual/joint degree programmes, recognition of courses and programmes, equivalence of degree etc. between the universities of India and other countries. The division also keeps records of MoUs/Collaboration with National/International Organization and representation of NAHPA in various International forums.
- (ix) NAHPA Students Information Services Division provides extensive information on university institutions, professional bodies, accredited courses conducted by all types of Institutions, teaching staff of institution departments, etc. It brings out comprehensive institution Handbook giving detailed information about the universities, their faculty, administration, and disciplines in which it offers courses at all levels. It also brings out handbooks on professional courses including Management Education, Engineering Education, Health Sciences Education, Computer Education and Distance Education. The Division also provides information to the stakeholders in India on their eligibility for admission to an Indian university or on the standing of an institution through e-mail, post and telephone. The NAHPA handbook is sent to all the NAHPA member Institution on complementary basis.
- (x) NAHPA Publication Division forwards the University Hand Book,

Directories, Journal, Bibliography of Doctoral Dissertations and other publication on complimentary basis to all the member universities of NAHPA.

- (xi) Vice Chancellors/ Directors on member universities/Institution may book NAHPA Guest House on very subsidized rate. Also, Conference/Meeting facilities of NAHPA may be utilized by all member universities/institutions for conducting various meetings.
- (xii) Besides this, there is a future plan to create an NAHPA Portal for providing value added services to the member universities.

The NAHPA Portal proposes to provide following services:

- (i) NAHPA Admission Portal will provide services for one stop admission to students and will provide visibility to University Institution academic programs
 - (ii) NAHPA Job Portal will provide a platform to Institution for wider publicity of vacancy advertisements
 - (iii) NAHPA portal will promote national and international Collaboration amongst member universities/Institution
 - (iv) NAHPA portal will be an Information store house for Indian and foreign students
 - (v) NAHPA portal will showcase best practices of all Institutions to enable learning from each other.
- (xiii) NAHPA also proposes to conduct many studies in higher education in partnership with member universities/Institutions.
 - (xiv) NAHPA is also proposing to launch a National Integration Train during vacations from North to South and from East to West of India for promoting cultural values in students of member universities in collaboration with identified universities.
